

## Disclosure Statement

In accordance with the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education's Standards for Commercial Support and the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education's Standards for Commercial Support, ASHP requires that all individuals involved in the development of activity content disclose their relevant financial relationships.
