Program Overview:

There is an educational need to provide the clinical pharmacy community with insight from a panel of notable clinical and pharmacy care management experts that addresses recent data and the evolving management of diabetes. This activity will instruct clinical pharmacy professionals on the benefits of early diagnosis and aggressive management of type 2 diabetes and its related complications. Recent findings as well as emerging evidence on the use of current and emerging anti-diabetics will be evaluated on their mechanism of action, safety, and appropriate therapeutic positioning including combination therapy and monotherapy. The impact of clinical inertia on patients with type 2 diabetes will be explored and a subsequent discussion will occur on the overall risks versus benefits of various treatment options on patient outcomes. This activity will also provide specific educational instruction for pharmacists to obtain the knowledge, competence, and performance needed to improve patient adherence to therapies for the treatment of type 2 diabetes.
