ACCP Scholarship Program for Meta-Analysis Training

HOPE Center, University of Arizona College of Pharmacy, June 18-20, 2018

PURPOSE: To encourage members to pursue and publish meta-analyses pertinent to clinical pharmacy practice and research.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS: Up to three \$500 scholarships are available for members attending the Meta-Analysis Training Program offered by the Center for Health Outcomes & PharmacoEconomic Research (HOPE Center), University of Arizona College of Pharmacy. Scholarship funds can be used for lodging, travel, meals, and other expenses associated with attending the training program.

ELIGIBILITY: Current ACCP member in good standing.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: June 1, 2018.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Recipients must complete the training program.
- Recipients must agree to present their completed work at an appropriate scientific meeting.
- Recipients must agree to submit their completed work to an appropriate target journal.

FACTORS TO BE CONSIDERED WHEN GRANTING SCHOLARSHIPS:

- Merit of application, without regard to age, race, sex, religion, or country of origin.
- Focus, study question, and significance to clinical pharmacy of the meta-analysis proposed.
- Appropriateness of proposed meta-analysis for presentation at a target scientific meeting and the potential for impact of the presentation at the proposed target meeting.
- Appropriateness of proposed meta-analysis for a target journal and the potential impact of publication in the proposed target journal.
- Recommendation and support of immediate supervisor (e.g., Department Director, Manager, Chairperson, Dean).

ADMINISTRATION OF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM: The ACCP Meta-Analysis Scholarship Committee will administer the program. Receipt of all completed applications will be acknowledged by email. The Scholarship Committee will review the applications and select the recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) based solely upon the information provided with the application. Recipients will be notified in writing by June 15. Recipients will be requested to provide a photograph and a brief biography to be posted on ACCP websites.

- b. Letter of support from immediate supervisor
- c. Applicant's current CV
