- To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide pharmacy reimbursement for COVID-19 related and future emergency services.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Equitable Community
- 5 Access to Pharmacist Services Act".

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1	SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF PHARMACIST SERVICES UNDER
2	MEDICARE PART B.
3	(a) COVERAGE.—Section 1861(s)(2) of the Social Se-
4	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(2)) is amended—
5	(1) in subparagraph (GG), by striking "and" at
6	the end;
7	(2) in subparagraph (HH), by striking the pe-
8	riod at the end and inserting "; and"; and
9	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10	paragraph:
11	"(II) pharmacist services and such services and
12	supplies furnished as an incident to the pharmacist's
13	service as would otherwise be covered under part B
14	if furnished by a physician or as an incident to a
15	physician's service that—
16	"(i) are furnished by a pharmacist, as li-
17	censed or otherwise authorized—
18	"(I) under State law; or
19	"(II) under section 319F–3 or section
20	361 of the Public Health Service Act, or
21	other similar Federal law;
22	"(ii) would otherwise be covered under part
23	B if furnished by a physician, or as incident to
24	a physician's service; and
25	"(iii) are services—

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1	"(I) for testing and testing-related
2	services for COVID–19, influenza, res-
3	piratory syncytial virus, or streptococcal
4	pharyngitis;
5	"(II) for the initiation of a drug regi-
6	men for COVID–19, influenza, or strepto-
7	coccal pharyngitis;
8	"(III) for the administration of a vac-
9	cine and related services for COVID–19 or
10	influenza;
11	"(IV) that address a public health
12	need related to a public health emergency
13	under section $319F-3$ or section 361 of
14	the Public Health Service Act, or other
15	similar Federal law; or
16	"(V) as determined by the Secretary
17	by program instruction or otherwise, in-
18	cluding the closing of gaps in health eq-
19	uity.".
20	(b) PAYMENT.—Section 1833(a)(1) of the Social Se-
21	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(a)(1)) is amended—
22	(1) by striking "and (DD)" and inserting
23	"(DD)"; and
24	(2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end
25	the following: "(EE) with respect to pharmacist

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1 services described in section 1861(s)(2)(II) for which 2 payment may be made under section 1848, the 3 amounts paid shall be equal to 85 percent (or 100 4 percent, in the case of such services furnished pursu-5 ant to a Federal emergency authority described in 6 clause (i)(II) of such section) of an amount deter-7 mined by the Secretary or the lesser of the actual 8 charge for the services or the physician fee schedule 9 amount provided under section 1848 if such services 10 had been furnished by a physician".

(c) REASSIGNMENT OF PAYMENT.—Section 1833 of
the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l) is amended by
adding at the end the new subsection:

14 "(ee) With respect to pharmacist services described 15 in section 1861(s)(2)(II) payment may be made on the basis of a claim or request for payment presented by the 16 17 pharmacist furnishing such services, or by a pharmacy, 18 hospital, critical access hospital, skilled nursing facility or nursing facility (as defined in section 1919(a)), physician, 19 group practice, or ambulatory surgical center with which 20 21 the pharmacist has an employment or contractual relation-22 ship that provides for payment to be made under this part 23 for such services to such pharmacy, hospital, critical ac-24 cess hospital, skilled nursing facility or nursing facility, 25 physician, group practice, or ambulatory surgical center.".

(d) PROHIBITION ON BALANCE BILLING FOR PHAR MACIST SERVICES.—Section 1842(b)(18)(C) of the Social
 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395u(b)(18)(C)) is amended by
 adding at the end the following:

5 "(vii) A pharmacist.".

6 (e) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-7 tion shall be construed—

8 (1) to limit flexibilities provided under section
9 410.32 of title 42, Code of Federal Regulations (or
10 any successor regulation) in response to COVID-19;
11 or

(2) to restrict the ability of pharmacies and
pharmacists to enroll and obtain reimbursement
under existing pathways under title XVIII of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.) as of the
date of the enactment of this Act, including reimbursement as mass immunizers.

18 (f)IMPLEMENTATION AUTHORITY.—Notwith-19 standing any other provision of law, the Secretary of 20 Health and Human Services shall implement the provi-21 sions of, and the amendments made by, this section by 22 interim final rule, program instruction, or otherwise not 23 later than the date that is 60 days after the date of the 24 enactment of this Act.
