- Communicate the impact of clinical pharmacists in practice, research, and education/training.

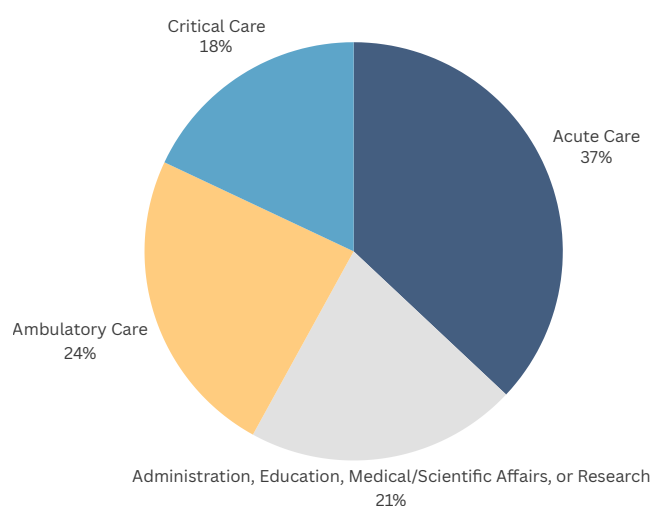
Position Clinical Pharmacists

- Promote an inclusive culture within the College.

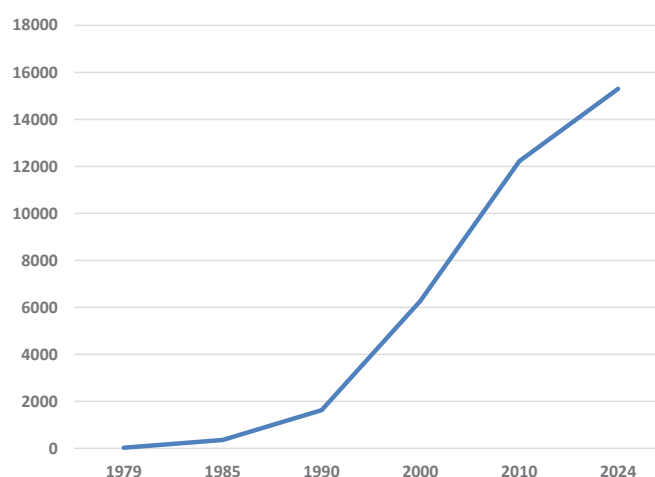
ACCP Member Postgraduate Training and Board Certification
