<p><b>Service or Program</b> The service or program section clearly describes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• what the service or program does,</li> <li>• where it is performed or delivered,</li> <li>• who it was provided for/to,</li> <li>• who provided the service or program, and</li> <li>• how it was developed and delivered.</li> </ul>	<p>0</p> <p>1</p> <p>2</p> <p>3</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does <i>not</i> meet the criterion, or the intent of the criterion, <i>at all</i></li> <li>• Meets <i>some</i> components of the criterion</li> <li>• Meets <i>most</i> components of the criterion</li> <li>• Meets <i>all</i> components of the criterion</li> </ul>
