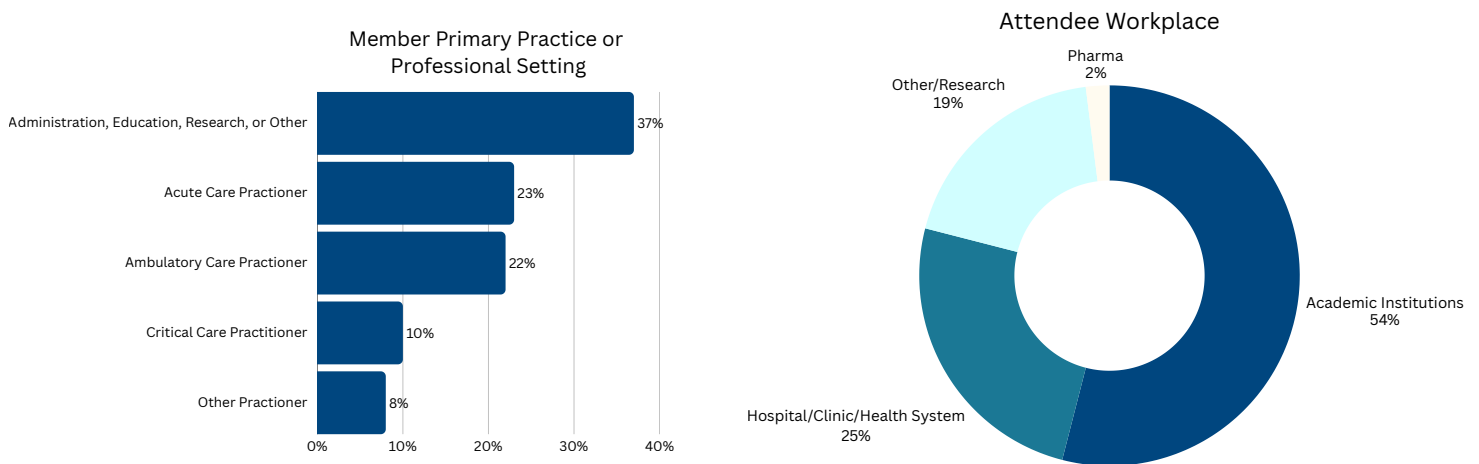
About ACCP:

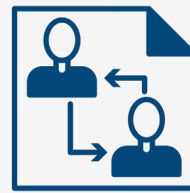

A fresh alternative to the traditional Exhibit Hall—connect with attendees where ideas and innovation meet.

ACCP Scientific Poster Hall



The Poster Hall is a central hub for sharing cutting-edge research and innovative ideas. During dedicated poster hours, attendees explore visual presentations of scientific studies and engage directly with researchers. ACCP hosts 120–140 posters per session across three days (Saturday–Monday), creating a dynamic environment for learning and networking.

ACCP Product Spotlight Theater

The Product Spotlight Theater is a designated presentation space located within the high-traffic Scientific Poster Hall, designed to draw attendees for focused product demonstrations and educational updates. The area features a large HD monitor connected to a laptop (presenters may bring their presentation on a thumb drive or submit it in advance), along with a microphone and speaker system to ensure clear audio. Seating will be arranged for approximately 50 attendees.

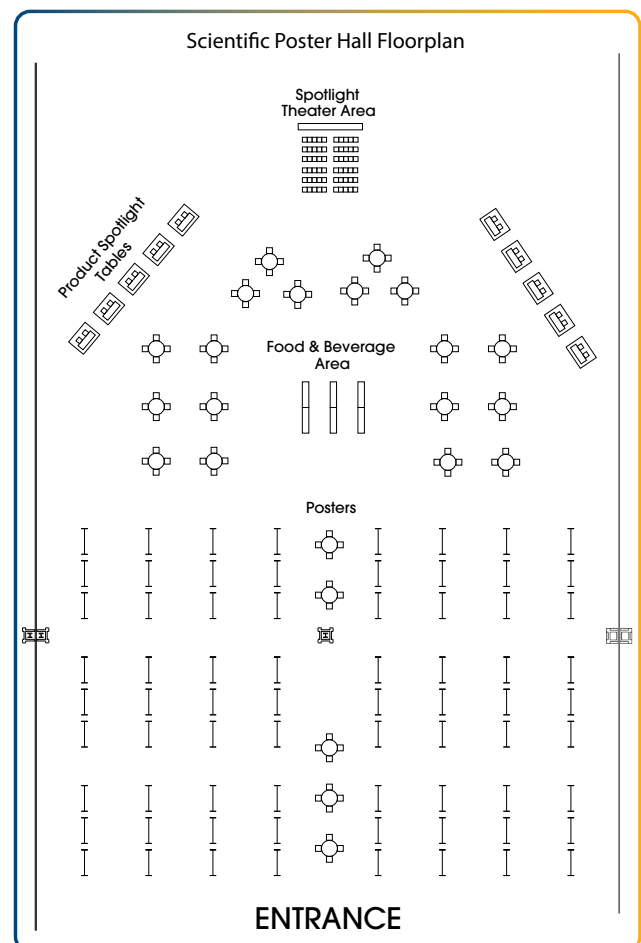

“ACCP reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to accept or reject any sponsorship application, or to terminate any sponsorship agreement. In the event of such termination, ACCP will issue a full refund of monies paid to ACCP back to the sponsor.”

General Sponsorship Benefits:

- Sponsor logo and link on the Annual Meeting webpage
- Sponsor logo or name recognition on Annual Meeting signage at registration
- Sponsor recognition in the October and November ACCP Member Newsletter
- One social media post across all platforms during the meeting dates
- Sponsor logo recognition in the Annual Meeting Daily Newsletter email to all attendees

Payment Terms:

ACCP will send an invoice for all sponsorship fees.

- Due Date: All payments are due within thirty (30) days of invoice.
- Payment Types Accepted: ACH Preferred, Credit Card (Visa, Mastercard, AMEX, Discover), or Check.
- If payment is not received by the due date, the sponsorship may be cancelled and resold.

Cancellation Policy:

- All sponsorship cancellations are subject to a fifty percent (50%) cancellation penalty.
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations received after August 14, 2026.

Logo Submission and Usage:

1. Logo Submission: The Sponsor agrees to provide a high-resolution version of their logo to ACCP within ten (10) business days of signing this agreement. The logo should be in a vector format (eg, .ai, .eps) or high-quality raster format (eg, .png, .jpg).
2. Usage Rights: ACCP is granted the right to use the Sponsor’s logo for the following purposes:
 - a. Inclusion in event promotional materials, such as flyers, brochures, and posters
 - b. Display on the Annual Meeting webpage and social media channels
 - c. Placement on event signage
3. Approval of Usage: ACCP agrees to use the Sponsor’s logo in a manner that maintains the integrity and quality of the logo.
4. Modification of Logo: ACCP agrees not to alter, distort, or modify the Sponsor’s logo in any way without prior written consent from the Sponsor.

Logo Usage Rights:
